



DENTAL CARE TIPS FOR DOGS AND CATS

Dental Brushing, Gel, or Spray

You can brush your pet's teeth at home with the appropriate toothbrush/toothpaste. Your pet may not be a fan of teeth brushing, you can consider using gels or sprays. These products are easy to apply & can help maintain oral hygiene.

Dental Water Additives

Water additives can be added to your pet's drinking water to work on and control plaque and tartar. This is not a substitute for teeth brushing, but can be an addition to your pet's daily routine.

Dental Friendly Treats & Toys

You can incorporate dental-safe & effective treats, chews and toys into your pet's routine. Make sure when choosing treats and toys that they are appropriate in size for your pet & their chewing habits.

Dental Wipes

For some pets, dental wipes can be an option. They are designed to be gentle on your pet's gums while also being effective with cleaning. These are a great option for pet's who won't allow dental brushing or pet's with small mouths. You can also use a wet washcloth at home.

Regular Check Ups / At Home Checks

Veterinary dental check ups are recommended once to twice yearly. At home keep an eye out for bad breath, difficulty eating, changes in eating habits, pawing at the face & mouth, etc.
